## SPSBS Breed Show 2021 General Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All ponies entered must be registered or eligible for registration in the SPSBS Stud Book.
2. All ponies must be named on the entry form and no entries taken on the day
3. Judging to commence at 8am and will not be delayed under any circumstances. Once judging of a class has commenced, no late arrivals will be admitted to the ring. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be in the ring on time.
4. The show committee reserves the right to amend, amalgamate or cancel any class and replace a judge if necessary.
5. The decision of the Judge(s) and the Show Committee is final
6. Any objection must be made in writing to the secretary within one hour of the alleged incident, together with a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
7. Foals must be over 5 weeks of age
8. Three year old fillies with foal at foot may not be shown
9. Brown ponies are classed as black
10. Ridden & Driven ponies must be 4 years old or over, no lactating mares in ridden & driven classes
11. Colts & Stallions 2yrs old and over must be shown bitted and it is advised they wear a stallion disc/badge
12. Stallions & Colts (except foals) may not be shown in hand by children under 14 yrs, or ridden by children under 12 yrs. No Stallions or Colts in Young Handler Classes
13. Correctly secured Riding hat must be worn whilst mounted on the showground and by handlers under the age of 14 yrs.
14. A novice pony must not have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in any class prior to the closing date of entries
15. A pony is eligible to compete in one ring only with the exception of Ridden, Driven, Young Handler, Progeny, and Veteran Classes.
16. If any pony is found to be suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, it must be removed from the showground immediately upon request of the show committee or vet.
17. The organisers shall not be liable for injury or loss from any cause or circumstance whatsoever to any person, animal or property. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor and competitor shall indemnify the show against such matters.
18. Only one handler per pony is permitted in the in hand classes
19. Exhibitors must be appropriately dressed, no individual stud, person or pony names displayed in the ring.
20. All riders must be a suitable height and weight for the pony they are riding
21. Ponies in ridden classes must be shown in a suitable bitted bridle
22. Whips may be no more than 30 inches long and spurs are not permitted
23. Should a rider fall off at anytime whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring with the rider dismounted and take no further part in the class.
24. Exhibitors should be aware a judge may not:
  - a. Place a pony which to his/her knowledge has been bred, sold, leased, or produced by the judge or his/her immediate family, partner, business partner or employer
  - b. Place a pony in which he/she has had a financial interest since 1<sup>st</sup> January of the preceding year
  - c. Place a stallion by whom he/she has had a mare stinted in this season
  - d. Judge any rider/handler who has shown a horse/pony owned or trained by him/her since 1<sup>st</sup> January of the preceding year.  
Should such a situation arise when such a pony appears a referee, preferably on the appropriate panel of judges, should be appointed to place the pony in question in its position in the class
25. No ponies to be left on a vehicle overnight
26. Mobile phones must be switched off whilst in the ring
27. Where classes are affiliated to societies other than the SPSBS, the other societies rules take precedence.
28. Classes 1,8, 10-21, 23-34, 36-39, 43-45, 52-55 are judged under the rules of the NPS  
Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non- members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult qualifying members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 2022.  
The highest placed pony in each class will qualify, Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second have already qualified.  
The NPS Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced Ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated.
29. Annual Equine Influenza vaccinations are required  
An initial course of two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete.
  - A first booster injection must be given between 150 and 215 days after the second injection of primary vaccination
  - Subsequent booster injections must be given at regular intervals of not more than 12 months.
  - The most recent booster injection must have been given within twelve calendar months prior to the pony competing.
  - The full course or booster must have been administered at least seven days before the competition.Foals under six months of age are exempt
30. **NEW for 2021** – there is a 4yr age class in each inhand section. 4yr old ponies may enter either this age class or the 4+ age class in the ring but cannot enter both.

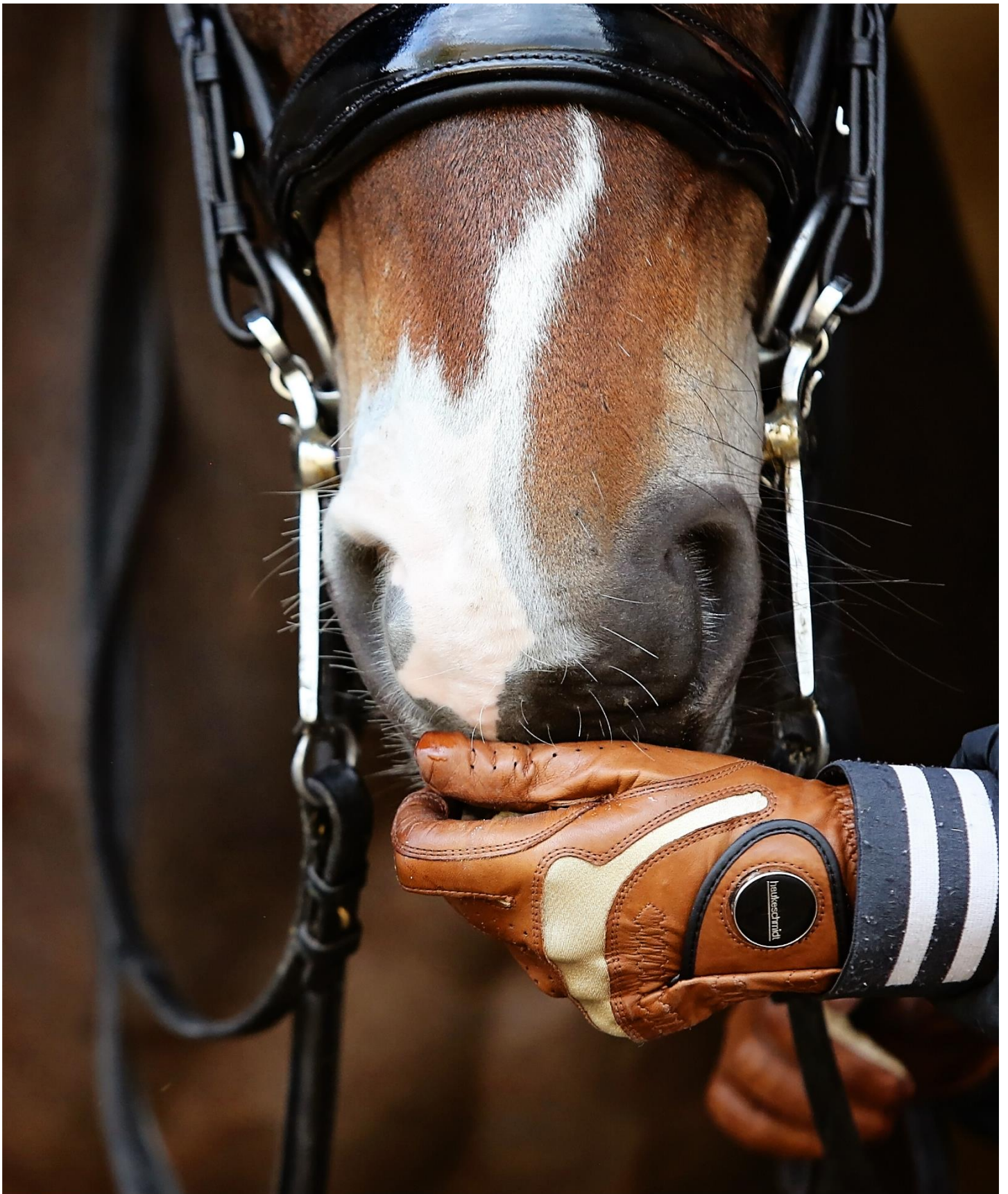

#### **NEW - Supreme Inhand Semi Final**

This Championship is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand qualifier at Stoneleigh Horse Show, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> September 2021. The Supreme In-Hand qualifier held at Stoneleigh Horse Show will offer two qualifying places for the Horse of the Year Show, NEC 6<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> October 2021. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion pony from Ring 1 (Black Ring), Ring 2 (Coloured Ring) and Ring 3 (Small Pony Ring) will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand Qualifier in 2021.

If the Champion has already qualified for the Horse of the Year Show 2021 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or are ineligible, then the Semi-Final will not be represented at Stoneleigh. Foal Champions and gelding 4ys and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for the Horse of the Year Show.
