1	Leading Rein Pony	Open to ponies of any type aged 4 years or over, mare or gelding. Riders not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be led at all times whilst in the ring & should not display any canter work. Pony not to exceed 12.2hh.
2	First Ridden Pony	Open to ponies of any type aged 4 years or over, mare or gelding. Riders not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies will not be asked to canter as a group but should demonstrate canter in their individual show. Pony not to exceed 14.2hh
CH1	Mini Championship	For 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 1 & 2

4	M&M Large Breeds Open Ridden	Open to mares, geldings & stallions aged 4 or over of any of Connemara, New Forest, Dales, Fell, Highland, Welsh Section C or Welsh Section D type. Ponies need not to be registered but should be true to type. No Leading Reins.
CH2	M&M Ridden Championship	For 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 3 & 4

7	Open Pony Ridden	Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 years old or over, not exceeding 14.2hh.
8	Open Horse Ridden	Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hh
CH3	Open Ridden Championship	For 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 5 to 8

11	Coloured Ridden Horse or Pony	Open to all broken coloured horses including spotted. Riders any age.
12	Veteran Horse or Pony Ridden	Open to any horse or pony aged 15 years and over. Riders any age.
13	Novice Ridden	Open to horses/ponies aged four years or over. Combination of horse and rider not to have won first prize in any showing class before 1st January in the current year.

33	Beginners WHP (20cm)	Course of rustic fences. Max Height 20cm. Riders not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. For riders just coming off the lead rein, may be accompanied but not led.
34	Open Working Hunter Pony (40cm)	Course of rustic fences. Max Height 40cm. Riders any age. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. No leading reins allowed.
35	Open Working Hunter Pony (60cm)	Course of rustic fences. Max Height 60cm. Riders any age. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. No leading reins allowed.
36	Open Working Hunter Pony (80cm)	Course of rustic fences. Max Height 80cm. Riders any age. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. No leading reins allowed.

40	Longest Mane & Tail	Horse/ponies any height and any age. Ridden or In-Hand. 1st Prize to the Horse or Pony with the Longest Mane & Tail.
41	Prettiest Mare	Horse/ponies any height and any age, Ridden or In-Hand. Open to Mares only.
42	Most Handsome Gelding	Horse/ponies any height and any age, Ridden or In-Hand. Open to Geldings only.
43	Best Miniature	Open to horses any age under 10.5hh (42"/106cm) in height. Any Youngstock entered must not be expected to exceed 10.5hh in height at maturity.
44	Best Giant	Open to all Heavy Horses. Any age and type, Ridden or In-Hand.
45	Best Solid Coloured	Open to all horses/ponies any age, any height of solid colouring (eg: horse's coat must be all one colour and have no patches or spots apart from on their head or legs) Ridden or In-Hand.
46	Best Thelwell look alike	Horse/ponies any height and any age. To be presented in the style of an official Norman Thelwell cartoon. Ridden or In-Hand
47	Horse or Pony the Judge would most like to take home	Horse/ponies any height and any age. Ridden or In-Hand
48	Best Rescue	Horse/pony any height and any age, Ridden or In-Hand. Horse/Pony to have been part of an official rescue service/programme eg: Blue cross/RSPCA/World Horse Welfare etc.

53	Best over 60 Years Handler or Rider	Horse/ponies any height and any age. Rider/Handler to have attained their 60th Birthday.
54	Concours D'Elegance	To be inhand or ridden astride or side saddle. Open to horses and ponies, mares and geldings, four years old and over. Riders any age. Costumes or traditional attire allowed. To be judged on the overall picture of elegance presented by horse/pony and rider including appearance, conformation and individual show.
