C22	Create a Teddy Bear	It is 100 years since Winnie the Pooh was published. You could draw or paint a bear.
C23	Make a Mobile	Make a Mobile using natural things, for example, twigs, flowers, feathers, pine cones. You can use string, ribbons, wool etc to hang things
C24	Make a Banner	Its 200 years since the Lancashire Mill Riots with hand loom weavers breaking into mills and sashing new, Lancashire looms to try and save their jobs. Imagine you are leading their campaign or trying to stop them.
C25	Write a Story	Write a Short Story on one side of A4 – with just words, or with your own illustrations, or as a comic strip. The opening sentence for the story is: “The Telephone rang in the darkness).” Remember to put your name and age on the back. (The first telephone call was 150 years ago)
